

C.H.C. Florida Youth Camp Rules and Regulations

1. **ALL CAMPERS** will be permitted and **expected to participate** in all guided activities of the camp except those disallowed by the parent(s) or guardian(s) by written statement.
2. **HEAD LICE INSPECTION** each camper will undergo immediately upon arrival and the **driver must remain** until all of his/her campers have passed this inspection. Any camper found to have either head lice or nits, will not be permitted to stay, but will be given a set of instructions on what will need to be done before returning to camp. After following all the instructions that are given, they may return to camp the next morning. They will be checked again by the camp personnel. If found to be free of any lice or nits, they may stay at camp. If found to still have any lice or nits, they will not be permitted to stay.
3. **WHAT NOT TO BRING** **radios, Cell Phones, tablets, CD players, music players, or electronic games.** Items of this sort will be collected by the Camp Director and stored in a safe place until the end of camp then returned to the owner at the time of departure.
4. **NO CELL PHONES** **If you need to call home, the Youth Director, Staff, or Dorm Parents will have a phone. All A & B teamers are to abide by the same Rules as Campers.**
5. **ADMISSION POLICY**- CHCYC is open to all who are willing to maintain the camp's Christian standard. A person must respect and cooperate with all staff members and campers, as well as participate in the camp schedule making sure to be on time for each activity. A daily schedule will be posted at different areas around the camp. Campers and workers are expected to do their fair-share in keeping the grounds, rooms, and equipment clean, in place, and working at all times.
6. **ACCIDENT INSURANCE**- Campers are covered by a limited accident policy while at camp. Insurance is provided with the enrollment fee to cover accidents while enrolled in Camp. This DOES NOT cover any pre-existing illness or illness incurred while at Camp. It is strictly an accident policy. Anyone enrolling with serious medical problems should notify the camp director by May 1st.
7. **MEDICATION**: All medication must be turned in at registration with a medical form completed (See C.E. Rep for this form.) It's up to the parent/guardian to ensure that all medication is picked up after camp; all medication will be discarded within 10 business days after camp if not claimed.
8. **CAMPERS WHO DRIVE** their own car will lock the car and turn the keys in to the camp dorm parents. Campers are not to spend free time in cars, listening to radio, etc.
9. **AFTER CURFEW** Campers may not leave the dorms except with a staff escort for legitimate purposes. Staff will be responsible to enforce this and inform the Director or Leaders in charge.
10. **NO RAIDING or TRICKS** are allowed, and under no circumstances are girls to be in the boy's dorms or boys in the girl's dorm- **NO EXCEPTIONS!!!!**
11. **SPENDING MONEY** The concession stand sells candy, drinks, and other snacks. The amount to bring is up to the individual; campers can open a tab on the day of registration or pay ahead of time.
12. **RESTRICTED AREAS** unless advised by the camp nurse, registered campers are restricted from sleeping during the day in any cabin, campers, or dorms. They are to remain with other campers during the day and night. Only A or B Teamers are allowed with their parents during camp.
13. **THE CAMP AREA**- Dormitory areas are off limits to the opposite sex. Anyone caught in violation of this rule will be sent home with the possible loss of the privilege to attend Youth Camp next year, pending Youth Committee decision. Camp Boundaries will be further explained in the orientation session. Once a person arrives on campus, he/she is not permitted to leave without the Director's permission. Anyone who will not cooperate with the Camp Director shall be talked with and if an agreement is not reached, the young person will be sent home. The Parent/Guardian is responsible for making these arrangements. All campers and staff must adhere to the daily schedule.
Everyone must attend all devotional services, with the exception of the cooks.

14. TUITION, DISCOUNTS & REFUNDS – For accurate recordkeeping, an application must be completed for every camper with EXCEPTION OF THE NURSERY. **The nursery, ages 3 and under,** is provided for the children of the camp workers and teachers. The nursery should only be used when parents are teaching their class or fulfilling any other camp duty they are assigned. All **“Day Campers” ages 4-7** must complete an application and pay the camp fee. No child under 8 yrs old will be allowed to stay in the dorm overnight UNLESS there is a guardian over 18 who will be held responsible for the child. Anyone who is over 19 and wishes to attend Camp should contact the camp director. Campers will receive a FREE 2022 Y.C. T-shirt IF their application is returned with a \$40 deposit, or full payment **BY MAY 7th, 2022**. All Applications received AFTER May 7th will **not** receive a free T-Shirt. After the **May 7th deadline**, if T-shirts are available, they may be purchased at the full price. **NO REFUND** will be given if the camper leaves the camp because of homesickness, discipline, family vacations, etc. No discount will be given for those arriving late.

15. WHAT TO BRING- Bed linens, pillows, blanket, bath linens, personal hygiene items, pajamas, and BIBLE are all necessary items. Enough clothing for each day and night service should be brought with the camper. Shaving cream (NO menthol or Aloe) and water guns for Fun Day must be turned in at registration with the camper’s name on them. Laundry Service is NOT available, so be sure to bring enough for the whole week!!! Label all belongings with a laundry marker, any articles left behind will be disposed of.

16. VISITORS – Campers maintain a very active schedule. Therefore, off campus visitors are discouraged. When a visitor does come on campus, he/she must immediately check in with Camp Staff to receive permission to be on campus. All visitors must obey ALL camp rules and leave before lights out at 11:00 pm. **A \$5.00 donation is asked to be provided for each visitor that has a meal provided by the camp.** Overnight visitors are not permitted without the Camp Director’s prior approval. (BACKGROUND CHECKS REQUIRED)

17. CAMP DRESS CODE

Youth Camp GIRLS Dress Guidelines:

Sanctuary Attire: Dresses and skirts must be worn to any **SANCTUARY SESSION day or night services.**

Non-Sanctuary Attire: MODEST Pants or knee length attire during the day for activities. All other pre-existing dress code guidelines would remain the same.

Youth Camp BOYS Dress Guidelines:

Sanctuary Attire: Full length pants and proper shirt must be worn to any **SANCTUARY SESSION day or night services.**

Non-Sanctuary Attire: MODEST Pants or knee length attire during the day for activities. All other pre-existing dress code guidelines would remain the same.

CAMP DRESS CODE –

Dress in keeping with the highest Christian standards while at camp. Show modesty in your choice of clothing. Clothing attire NOT ALLOWED; occult or cult symbols, clothing with offensive prints, spaghetti straps, showing of undergarments and shredded or torn attire.

FEMALES dresses or skirts must be knee length with no splits above the knee.

NO sleeveless dresses/ shirts, cut out sleeves on shirts or dresses, unless worn with a jacket. Shorts may be worn under dresses. We do not permit wearing tank tops, or garments that leave a midriff or cleavage exposed, including see-through garments. Shoes must be worn at all times.

At NO TIME should you be seen outside of your cabin without clothing that meets these expectations.

For females, we suggest make-up in moderation (no heavy eye make-up). Earrings should be studs and post only, no loop or dangling earrings. No other pierced jewelry is permitted. ONLY ONE earring per ear. Female leggings will require the same additional coverage as ladies hosiery.

MALES SHOULD NOT WEAR ANY EARRINGS. No other pierced jewelry is permitted.

A/ B Teamers are to abide by the same dress code/ Rules as Campers.
